Memo on compliance with fire safety requirements for dorm residents of MSUT ''STANKIN''

Residents of the dorm are required to:

- comply with fire safety requirements;

- know the place of storage and be able to use fire extinguishing tools, firefighting equipment and automatic fire alarm equipment;

- learn the plan (diagram) of evacuation in case of a fire in the dorm, know the location of fire escapes and emergency escape routes.

In order to avoid a fire in the dorm, it is prohibited:

- smoke in the premises of the hostel, on the balconies, as well as in the territory next to the building of the dorm (closer than 15m);

- bring, store and use hookahs, candles, pyrotechnic products, explosives, flammable and combustible liquids, flammable substances and materials, any other objects, devices, during the operation of which an open fire is used or smoke occurs;

- to clutter up corridors, halls, staircases, passages to escape routes and to places where fire extinguishing means are placed with furniture and personal belongings;

- misuse and damage fire escapes, fire extinguishers, fire alarms, fire equipment;

- use any gas equipment.

When using electrical networks and electrical appliances, it is prohibited:

- use extension cords without grounding and not equipped with a protective shutdown button, faulty and self-made electrical appliances and equipment;

use heaters, irons, kettles, etc., not equipped with an automatic shutdown button
/ function;

- connect more than two powerful consumers of electricity to one outlet at the same time;

- independently (without agreement with the administration of the hostel) install sockets, switches, any electrical equipment, install electrical wiring;

- leave unattended electrical appliances and equipment connected to the network;

- place on electrical appliances, lamps, etc. foreign objects, modify or disrupt the design of electrical appliances.

In the rooms intended for cooking:

- carefully use of the equipment, do not allow contamination of the stoves when cooking, observe cleanliness and order in the room;

- do not leave the cookers turned on unattended; after cooking, make sure that the equipment you used is turned off;

- do not use stoves for drying clothes and heating the room.

Strict adherence to fire safety rules will allow you to prevent a fire and protect your life and health!
