Restriction of the international payment	Withdrawal of funds from foreign cards of Visa
system	and Mastercard payment systems in the territory
	of the Russian Federation is prohibited from
	<u>10.03.22</u> . Clients can withdraw money only from
	cards issued in the territory of the Russian
